
### Green Hub gets a boost

Our **Green Hub** project got a great boost recently when the **Lower East Side Business Improvement District**, our partners in the project, received funding from the New York State Regional Economic Development Councils 2014 Awards. The grant will permit a feasibility study of the project to proceed in the coming months, keeping it moving on a swift and positive trajectory.

Green Hub takes a monolithic parking structure on Essex and Delancey streets in Manhattan and shifts it into a lively neighborhood crossroads by introducing bicycle parking, a small cafe, community workspace, rooftop garden plots, and other relevant community spaces.
